## New law making license harder to obtain for teens

Indiana teenagers are going to have to hold off a little bit longer on getting their licenses.

State legislators have changed the law to being 15 years and a half before getting a legal permit.

Currently, teenagers have to be 16 years and 30 days to get a license, but soon it might be 16 years and 180 days.

Some people may think that a couple of months will not make a

difference, but the legislators seem to think it will.

Also, if this law is passed, anybody under the age of 18 will not be able to use their cell phone while driving.

That change would go into effect this summer.

The bill is not certain yet as it will return to the Indiana State Senate for consideration of changes made by the State House of Representatives.
